From the North:

Traveling south on I-25, take Exit 233 to Alameda Blvd. Take Alameda Blvd. west to Second Street. Turn right (north) on Second Street. Proceed approximately 0.8 mile to an unpaved road just past the Bernalillo County Sheriff's Posse sign. Turn right (east) and proceed approximately 0.2 mile to the arena.

From the South:

Traveling north on Interstate 25, take Exit 233 to Alameda Blvd. Take Alameda Blvd. west to Second Street. Turn right (north) on Second Street. Proceed approximately 0.8 mile to an unpaved road just past the Bernalillo County Sheriff's Posse sign. Turn right (east) and proceed approximately 0.2 mile to the arena.

From the East:

Traveling west on I-40, take the I-25 exit going north. Traveling north on I-25, take Exit 233 to Alameda Blvd. Take Alameda Blvd. west to Second Street. Turn right (north) on Second Street. Additional Site Information

Rings and Equipment

Both rings will be enclosed by pipe fencing and netting. Gates that open and close will be used at the entry and exit of each ring. There will also be an enclosure surrounding one warm-up jump. All contact equipment (dogwalks, a-frames and see saws) and tables will have a rubberized surface.

Additional Site Information

- **DOGS ARE NOT ALLOWED IN THE RESTROOMS OR ON THE GRASS AREA IN FRONT OF THE POSSE CLUBHOUSE.** Any exhibitor failing to comply may be excused from the test without any refund if the Test Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement.
- **This test will be held in a livestock facility.** It is possible that there could be livestock in pens adjacent to the rings and crating areas. If your dog is not under reasonable control around livestock, you may not wish to attend this event. Rings will be surrounded by a lightweight netting. Dogs need to be under reasonable off-leash control since this may not provide a solid barrier around the ring.
- There is ample parking in the large gravel/dirt lot surround the arena. Please do not park or set up crates in the fire zone. No parking spaces may be saved overnight.
- **RV Parking:** Self-contained RV parking is permitted at the site at no charge. Electrical and water hookups are available at \$25/night. Contact the Sheriff's Posse Representative upon arrival or sometime during your stay. All vehicles with generators turned on must be parked at least 50 feet from the arena during show hours. No dumping of holding tanks, grey water, or sewage on the trial grounds or parking lot is permitted.
- **No overnight security will be provided.** The grounds are fenced and there will likely be RV's parked overnight, but there will be no hired overnight security at this trial site.

- **Crating space** is available on the north side of the arena and under the bleachers on the south side. Please do not set up crates in the fire zone or up in the bleachers. You may bring shade tents for shade, but be aware that the ground surrounds the arena is very hard and wind is often an issue in Albuquerque. Crates and tents may be left overnight, but Southwest Agility Team, the BCSP, and USDAA will not be responsible for any lost or damaged items left at the show site.
- **Seating space is ample at this site.** There are bleachers on the south side of the arena. Please stay clear of the ring entrances and exits and the practice jumps. Due to safety and space concerns, no exhibitor chairs will be allowed between the rings.
- Exhibitors and handlers will be held responsible for clean conditions in and around their crating and parking areas.
- No dogs are allowed to be left unattended at the site overnight.

Entries & Acceptance

Express & Overnight Entries

Entries sent by Fedex, Express Mail or other courier service will only be accepted if the waiver allowing delivery **without signature** is signed. The club will not be responsible for deliveries delayed if a signature is required.

No Entry For Exhibition Only

No entry "For Exhibition Only" shall be accepted, except as provided for in Chapter 10 when Intro Program classes are offered. See additional note for club policy regarding dogs that measure up.

General Rule on Eligibility

This event is sanctioned by the United States Dog Agility Association, Inc. ("USDAA").

This test is open to all persons with dogs being at least 18 months of age (14 months of age pursuant to Chapter 10 for Intro Program when offered OR for Sanctioned Match), regardless of pedigree or absence thereof, who have a current registration with USDAA and whose owners and the dog's handler are currently in good standing with USDAA.

This event will be held under USDAA® Official Rules and Regulations, a copy of which may be viewed and printed online at www.usdaa.com, as [amended](#)

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Policy on Refusal of Entry

The Organizing Committee of an event may refuse the entry of any competitor or dog for just cause should the Committee view that participation by the competitor or dog could be prejudicial to the sport. However, in such case, the Committee must notify the competitor in writing upon receipt of entry, but in no case, more than three days following the event closing date for acceptance of entries. The burden of responsibility for the appropriateness of such action rests solely with the host group and its Organizing Committee.

NSF Check/Credit Card

Any check or credit card that is charged back by the bank or other financial institution may be assessed a service charge of up to \$40 per incident at the discretion of the host group.

Returned checks or credit card returns do not constitute a valid entry. Amounts shall be paid within 30 day of postmarked notice of the returned payment if such date follows the event date. Any fees not received within 30 days of notice will result in cancellation of event results for all classes related to the entry for which payment was made. No reinstatement of results is possible, and all awards must be returned within 10 days of notification or the dog's registration may be suspended pending restitution.

Any unpaid fees or shortfalls must be paid prior to the start of the event, or entry is canceled without recourse.

Refund Policy

There shall be NO REFUNDS for entries withdrawn after the closing date for acceptance of entries, for absentee, dismissal from the event as a result of disciplinary action, dismissal from a class, or for any other reason. Also, no entry fees will be refunded if the event cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, acts of terrorism, fire, "act of God", public emergency, strike, or any other cause beyond the control of the host organization.

Bitches In Season

SWAT will offer refunds for Bitches in Season, up to the day before the event. Please notify the Trial Secretary prior to the start of the event. No Exceptions.

Refund For Overpayment

There shall be NO REFUNDS for overpayment less than \$15.00.

Handler Discount

Handlers 18 years of age and under will receive a 50% discount on entry fees.

Submission of Entries with Secondary Move-Up Date

All entries or cancellations must be received at the Secretary's address no later than the closing date, after which time no entries will be accepted or cancelled. For entries received by the closing date, the level of entry into a given class may be advanced by notifying the Secretary in writing via email by the "Secondary Closing Date". No other changes, cancellations or additions may be made after the initial closing date.

To be accepted, entries must be complete, signed (by parent or legal guardian if handler is a minor), received by the closing date and accompanied by the correct fees and include a valid USDAA registration number on a completed registration form.

Next-Day Move-Ups Allowed At This Event

Competitors earning a qualification during the Event that is needed to complete a title may advance their level THE NEXT DAY at the same event, i.e. move-ups on consecutive days ARE allowed.

Competitors are responsible for keeping accurate records of their qualifying scores and the judges from whom these scores were earned prior to this event to ensure that the dog is eligible to move up based upon scores earned at this Event. Competitors are advised to confirm scores earned with the scorekeeper and judge at the conclusion of a class to ensure the qualifying score has been accurately calculated and awarded in accordance with regulations. If for any reason it is determined that the score or previous scores were inaccurate, making the entry ineligible for the higher level class, any results (including awards) shall be forfeited and the entry will be deemed invalid without refund or other recourse.

Move-up forms supplied by this event must be used to notify the secretary BEFORE she leaves the site the day on which you earn your title.

Check-in & Measuring

Dog Measurements & Certification

All dogs not jumping 24" in the Championship Program or 20" in the Performance Program at local and regional events must be measured unless they have permanent USDAA or World Cynosport Dog Registration status or a temporary card with 3 signatures as required by the regulations, making the dog eligible for their jump height (prior to 3 years of age). Please note that only dogs 18 months of age and entered in the event may be officially measured.

Advance Request for Measurement Verification

When not entering an event electronically, please send a copy of one the following items to facilitate the check-in process:

- photocopy of permanent dog registration card,
- printout of the dog-information page from your USDAA® competitor web account, or
- copy of your check-in letter from USDAA indicating your temporary card has been accepted by the USDAA office and your permanent registration card is in process.

A Dog that Measures Up at Check-In - May Run FEO

If a judge's measurement of a dog at check-in establishes that the dog is ineligible for the height class in which entered, the competitor may

- Run the dog at the higher height in the same program based upon the measurement,
- Modify the entry to enroll the dog in the proper height class in the Performance Program,
- Modify the entry to enroll the dog in the proper height class in the Veterans Program if the dog is 8 years old
- Run For Exhibition Only (FEO) at the next lowest jump height, but only in the program entered.

Because entry into a higher height is permitted in the Performance and Championship Programs, a dog measuring lower may not be moved to a lower height in either program.

General Entry Conditions

Prohibitions on Aids & Devices

No leads, collars, food, toys or other aids or devices shall be permitted on the course at any time, except as provided for in Chapter 10 when Intro Program classes are offered, or in Chapter 8 when Junior Handler Program classes are offered.

Statement of Responsibility

Competitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs, children or guests. A competitor whose dogs, children or guests create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Organizing Committee, be asked to leave the test site.

Policy on Fault Limits

In the event of a larger entry, fault limits may be set at the discretion of the Organizing Committee and/or Judge without pre-event notice.

Spam Blocker

Confirmations will be sent via email using the secretary's address. If you have a spam blocker on your email account, please configure it to allow email from the secretary's address since confirmations will be sent from this account.

Class Descriptions

Masters Challenge Biathlon

This Biathlon consists of two classes; Masters Challenge Standard and Masters Challenge Jumpers. While these two classes will count as titling runs, they also form the biathlon where scores will be converted to time plus faults. After the two classes, scores will be combined to calculate those dogs in each jump height earning eligibility by posting an overall score in the top 25%. A dog scoring an elimination in either class will be eliminated from Biathlon award contention.

Titling Class Rules & Descriptions

One or more titling classes shall be held at this Event from those described in Chapters 3 - 8 of USDAA Official Rules & Regulations, which are downloadable from www.usdaa.com/rulesReg_eBook.cfm, and any amendments there to, which are downloadable from www.usdaa.com/rulesReg.cfm, each of which are hereby incorporated by reference.

Tournament Class Rules & Descriptions

One or more tournament classes are being held at this event, the rules and description of which may be downloaded on the Internet at www.usdaa.com/gen_formDoc.cfm, and are hereby incorporated by reference. A written copy may be obtained from the Event secretary.

Mixed-Height Pairs Entry Allowed

Dogs entered as partners in pairs relay at this event may be combined without regard to jump height, i.e. a mini dog may be entered as a partner with an open dog. Any pair consisting of at least one open dog must qualify in accordance with the QCT set forth by the judge of record for Open Pairs AND will be considered an open pair for placement purposes.

Veterans Program Classes

Veterans level classes offered at this event are open to a competitor with any dog that is at least eight (8) years of age as of the first day of this event. Previous experience in the sport sufficient to establish proficiency and confidence in performance is strongly encouraged. A dog entered in a Veterans class on a day may not be entered in that class in the Championship or Performance Programs. Team & Versatility Pairs Measure-up Policy

The handler of a dog entered in Team or Versatility Pairs must notify the secretary immediately should their dog be required to jump a higher height by virtue of the judge's measurement. The dog must jump the higher jump height in order to be eligible to earn a qualifying score in the tournament. If entered in Team, the dog that measured up may be moved to Versatility Pairs. If the handler chooses **not** to have their dog jump the higher height or move to PVP, their entry is effectively withdrawn. The competitor may or may not run for exhibition only (earning no individual class qualifications or tournament qualification for the team) solely at the discretion of the event secretary; there shall be no refund of fees paid.

If the change in height makes the dog ineligible for their team (three jump heights), the secretary will make every effort to form complete teams from dogs available. A move-up in height for dogs in Versatility Pairs does not affect their team composition, but may result in a change in their position in the running order because of the height composition of the Pair.

Prizes & Awards

Titling Class and Tournament Awards

TITLING CLASSES

Placement Ribbons: 1st through 4th place ribbons for each jump height in each titling class. 1st through 4th place ribbons for each of the Mini and Open Pairs.

Qualifying Rosettes: A maroon ribbon for a qualifying score in all titling classes.

TOURNAMENTS

Grand Prix/Performance Grand Prix: The 1st place qualifying dog in each jump height will earn a "bye" voucher, permitting them to directly advance to the Final Round of a Regional Championship. An overlay ribbon (GP-maroon/white; PGP-maroon/pink) will be awarded to all qualifiers. 1st through rth place ribbons will be awarded in each jump height.

Steeplechase/Performance Speed Jumping: For Round 1, special qualifying ribbons (STP-maroon/gold; PSJ-maroon/yellow) will be awarded to all qualifiers. For Round 2, prize money will be awarded per the schedule provided in the Tournaments section of the Forms and Documents library on the

USDAA website (www.usdaa.com).

Team/PVP Overall: For each team member, 1st through 4th place ribbons are available and a maroon ribbon for a qualifying score. For all other qualifiers, maroon qualifying ribbons are available.

Biathlon/Perf. Biathlon: 1st through 4th place ribbons for each jump height. A maroon ribbon for a qualifying score.
