With some possible exceptions, all classes and Ex/M height groups will **walk/run**. The exceptions are classes and groups that need to be split in order to avoid crowded walk-throughs and starting a group height in the other ring to avoid an idle ring. The decision whether to split a group or class will be announced in the Exhibitors' Letter, during the morning briefing each day, and/or during the class briefings. Exhibitors are responsible for listening to the briefings to be aware of announcements regarding the walk/run schedule.

Please consult the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials for a complete description and eligibility for entry into these classes. The exhibitor is fully responsible for entering the dog in the correct class(es)/height divisions. Dogs running in a lower height division than they are eligible for will be eliminated.

SIMPLIFIED JUMP HEIGHT CARD PROCESS

When filling out the entry form, there is a section at the top of the form for exhibitors to designate whether your dog needs to be officially measured. Please check the appropriate box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dog on the *Dogs to Be Measured List*. It is not required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during day of show check-in.

MEASURING and HEIGHT CARD INFORMATION

Dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form must be measured/wicketed by the **Judge of Record** PRIOR to running in their class and this measurement will be valid for that weekend of trials only. The exception to this requirement is a dog entered in the 24" or 24C height divisions. However, if a **Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO)** or an **Agility Field Rep** is present, **ALL** dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form must be measured at some time during the trial or cluster of trials. This does not preclude having the dog wicketed by the Judge of Record if the VMO or Rep is not available to measure the dog **before** its first run of the trial or cluster of trials. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running and failure to do so will result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores.

Dogs may arrive any time prior to judging if the dog has a valid temporary or permanent jump height card. Otherwise, they must be available for measuring prior to the start of their class if a VMO or AKC Field Rep is available to measure dogs. All dogs not needed for further judging will be excused.

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate.

Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations it includes both sexes.

Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of register able breeds that may participate.

OBSTACLES AND RING CONDITIONS

Obstacles will meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the Regulations for Agility Trials. All classes will take place indoors on dirt. Ring size will be 100x100.

ENTRY FEES PER DAY

First entry of each dog each day (includes \$4.50 AKC recording fee) **\$22.00**.
Second or more of same dog (includes a \$4.50 AKC recording fee)..... **\$15.00**

Junior Handlers receive a 50% discount on all entry fees.

No entries will be accepted by phone, fax or hand delivery. Express mail entries must include the signature waiver allowing them to be left at the secretary's address. Inquiries may be directed to: **Cindy Blanton** nmtss.546@gmail.com. No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.

Illegible entries will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry and the Trial Secretary will add a **\$25.00** collection fee to the amount of each returned check.

Accepting ENTRIES ONLINE through LabTestedOnline.com. This trial is accepting online entries through <https://www.labtestedonline.com/>. During the first 48 hours after opening, the initial limit of entries designated as either online or paper will be as follows. 200 runs online, 500 runs paper each day. If either form of entry has not filled at the end of the 48-hour time period, the club reserves the right to decrease or increase either one accordingly.

CATALOGS: A limited number of catalogs will be available for viewing at the trial secretary booth. None will be sold. Running order sheets will be available at no charge and posted online after closing with one copy posted at the trial site during the trials.

DIRECTIONS TO THE TRIAL SITE

DIRECTIONS TO THE SHOW SITE:

From I-40 East: Exit onto Louisiana Blvd. (Exit 162), and head south. Turn right (west) onto Lomas Blvd; turn left (south) onto San Pedro. From San Pedro, if you have a parking pass, enter the fairgrounds through **Gate 6**, the first gate on the left (the horse gate); otherwise, enter through Gate 3. Once inside the fairgrounds, the Horse Arena is in the northwest corner just past the Dairy Barn.

From I-40 West, exit San Mateo south (Exit 161 A). Turn left (east) onto Lomas and right (south) onto San Pedro. See above for the rest of the directions.

COURSE WALK-THROUGHS AND WARM-UP INFORMATION

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, during a walk-through period held prior to the start of the class. The walk-through is restricted to handlers entered in that class only. Handlers with multiple dogs at events with multiple rings may request to walk with a height group other than the one their dog is entered in if a conflict is imminent. Whenever possible, dogs should be moved up or down in the running order within their assigned height group to avoid a conflict.

Exhibitors who need to move a dog to avoid a conflict **MUST** notify the Gate Steward, Chief Ring Steward or Scribe **BEFORE** the walk-through ends. Exhibitors may not make the change on the Agility Gate equipment – ask the Gate Steward, Chief Ring Steward or Scribe for assistance. **Handlers who miss the assigned walk-through due to volunteering for another class will be guaranteed a walk-through time. They should check with the trial chair or chief steward.**

A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, may be provided for exhibitors. The warm-up area is to be used exclusively for warming up the dog and not for training or relieving of the dog.

RIBBONS, AWARDS, AND PRIZES

Strip Ribbons will be awarded in each jump height division in each class as follows:

<i>First Place</i>	<i>Blue</i>

A New Title rosette will be awarded to all dog and handler teams finishing a title. A MACH or PACH rosette and decorated MACH/PACH bar will be awarded to all dog and handler teams that attain their MACH or PACH.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS SAFETY, BEHAVIOR and LIABILITY

The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The **Weimaraner Club of Albuquerque** and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. The **Weimaraner Club of Albuquerque** reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the **Weimaraner Club of Albuquerque** or any official thereof.

All dogs must be on leash at all times when on trial grounds except when in the designated warm-up area or competing on the course.

REFUNDS

- **No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.**
- **No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee.**
- **A withdrawal from the trial after the closing date due to an injury and/or illness to the dog will be eligible for a refund up to 75% of the total entry fee paid. A veterinarian's notice of injury or illness will be required for the refund to be issued. Refunds for withdrawal caused by illness or injury to the handler will be considered on a case-by-case basis, if the Trial Secretary or Trial Chair is notified by 7:00 am on the first day of the trial.**
- **Bitches in season are not permitted to compete in Agility Trials. As such, the club will refund 100% per day of the entry fee paid for bitches unable to compete for this reason. In order to receive a refund, the handler must notify the Trial Secretary by 7:00 am on the first day of the trial.**
- **No refunds will be issued for any amount less than \$15.00**

ADDITIONAL SITE INFORMATION

The Horse Arena is located on the northwest corner of the campus of Expo New Mexico. It is climate controlled with a packed dirt surface. There is plenty of room for crating and lots of space for walking dogs outdoors.

Crating/Seating: Crating is on floors in the building lobby or side entries of the arena. Crates may be left overnight; however, WCA/SWAT and Expo New Mexico will not be responsible for any lost or damaged items left at the show site. Security is provided by Expo New Mexico. Doors are locked at 6:00 pm and opened at 6:30 am. No dogs may be left in the building overnight. There are bleachers available for seating. No dogs may be tied to or crated upon the bleachers.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Trial Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available at various locations around the show grounds

There **may** be a food vendor at this trial. Confirmation of a food vendor will be included in the exhibitor's letter. In addition, there are fast food restaurants nearby, including a McDonalds across the street, and there is a Smith's grocery store very close. Be aware, however, that exhibitors who do not buy a 3-day parking pass will be charged the \$10.00 parking fee upon re-entry after leaving the grounds. Only exhibitors who buy a 3-day parking pass will have in-and-out privileges.

Exhibitor Parking

The Dairy Barn may not be available for parking or may be available on a limited basis. There is ample parking space outside of the Dairy Barn near the arena. Please follow signs regarding available parking areas.

All parking is paid parking.

Day-Of Parking: Expo allows you to purchase daily passes for \$10.00 a day if you go through the main gate (Gate 3). Exhibitors will not have in/out privilege with the Day Of parking pass and will not be able to enter through Gate 6 if you must purchase a daily pass.

Option to purchase 3-day parking passes prior to trial: Exhibitors may obtain prepaid parking passes through SWAT. **The 3-day parking passes are \$15.00** and allow unlimited entrance and exit to the EXPO. Exhibitors with these passes are required to enter the EXPO through Gate 6.

If you want a 3-day parking pass, you must send a check, payable to SWAT, to **Donna Crary-Johnson**, 4829 Shin Ave NE, Rio Rancho, New Mexico 87144.

Parking pass requests and fees must be received by Donna Crary- Johnson on or before Wednesday, July 31, 2026, so she can get your passes to you before the trial. You must include a Self-Addressed Stamped Envelope with your payment. **Please be sure your return envelope has a stamp on it.**

RV Parking

RV RATES – If you want water and/or electricity, the RV rate is \$60.00 per night. Dry Camp \$45.00 per night without hook-up or any amenities. Please note: very few, if any, RV spots have a dump station at the site. There is a dump station on EXPO grounds that you can drive to.

All RV parking, including location, is at the discretion of EXPO NM.

Here's how it works for RVs at Expo: To reserve a spot, email **Donna Crary- Johnson** at **least one week before the trial** at drjaussie@gmail.com and provide the following information: name, email address, date of your arrival, the size of your RV and whether you will have a tow vehicle, and what services you are requesting (water/electric or dry). When you arrive, enter the fairgrounds at Gate 3 on Copper and San Pedro. Go to the stop sign and pull into one of the parking lots you see. Call the number for the 24/7 security guard - **505-401-4095** - and they will come to meet you and take you to your site. The Expo will email you an invoice during the week of the trial, and you will pay online at that time. **Please watch for the email invoice in the day(s) before the trial.**

No overnight parking will be allowed at the trial site other than RVs. time.

HOTEL AND RV INFORMATION MOTEL ACCOMMODATIONS

A pet deposit may be required. Please check with hotels for policies and restrictions. The Weimaraner Club makes no guarantee that these motel's pet policies will be the same on the day of the trial. Please pick up after your dogs, keep your dog's quiet in the hotel, and keep your room tidy so dog lovers will always be welcome at these or any hotels.

If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine Partners' program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.
